Assisted Home Performance with ENERGY STAR®

This program helps income-qualified homeowners finance eligible energy efficiency improvements. Those who qualify receive a discount that covers 50% of eligible upgrades up to \$4,000.

EmPower NY

This program provides no-cost energy efficiency services to income-eligible New York residents.
