Need for Food and Childcare March 17, 2020

Good Afternoon,

Governor Cuomo has requested all school districts provide two services to the community, childcare for healthcare workers and first responders who are vital to the response efforts and food provision for any community members who are in need. Scarsdale is developing plans to accomplish these requests.

For our community members who are serving vital roles in the response to COVID-19 and have no other means of childcare please email childcare@scarsdaleschools.org with your request. Please include your name, address, the number and age of children, your direct supervisor's contact information (to verify employment and eligibility), and the days and hours needed. Child Care can be provided tentatively from 9am to 6pm on weekdays during the closure. Again, this service is only for vital roles in response to the outbreak and who do not have other childcare alternatives.

Additionally, the District will start providing breakfast and lunch "grab and go" bags starting Thursday March 19th between 11am and 12pm at the Quaker Ridge Elementary School (125 Weaver St., Scarsdale, NY). This distribution will continue every weekday during the closure. There are no restrictions on this service with the exception of living in the Scarsdale School District. In order to prepare an appropriate amount of food please fill out the form at this [link](#). Pick will be provided curbside at the bus circle and you will be asked to show your ID. To respect the efforts to reduce the risk of spread please do not leave your car or try to enter the building, staff will meet you at the curb.
