Tropical Storm Isaias: Storm Debris

In response to the volume of storm debris in the wake of Tropical Storm Isaias, and to assist with recovery and maximize the efficiency of the clean-up efforts of organic material removal from private property, the Village is allowing property owners and contractors to dispose of tree logs, branches, and other organic material from the storm at the [Recycling Center](#), located at 110 Secor Road. All disposal fees will be waived starting on Thursday, August 05, and ending at close of business on Saturday, August 22, 2020, subject to the rules cited below.

Storm Debris Drop-Off Rules

- Only Tropical Storm Isaias-related storm debris from Scarsdale residences will be accepted.

To be eligible for free disposal, the property owner must certify in writing that the debris came from the subject property. The certification must be signed by the property owner and include both the date and time of signature. The contractor must then deliver the associated debris to the Sanitation Yard within a reasonable amount of time thereafter, presenting the certification to Sanitation staff at that time.

- Property owners may also drop-off their own debris at the Sanitation Yard free of charge during this period.
- Only organic storm debris will be accepted, e.g., tree logs, stumps, branches, etc.
- All organic material must be free from contamination, including unauthorized debris, such as building materials.
- After Saturday, August 22, all usual disposal requirements and fees apply, in accordance with Scarsdale Village Code [Chapter 179](#).
