Village Election Info and Updates

The [Village Election](#) (links to Election Info webpage) will be held on Tuesday, September 15, 2020.

All Election Districts (Numbers 1 through 19) will be voting on Tuesday, September 15, 2020, at the Scarsdale Congregational Church, 1 Heathcote Road, in Dyckman Hall. Hours of the election are 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. For those choosing to vote in-person, please note that social distancing and sanitization protocols will be in-place to minimize any potential exposure to COVID-19. However, absentee voting is also available.

Governor Cuomo has [authorized voters](#) to request a Village Election absentee ballot due to a concern about risk of illness to oneself or others. Concerns about COVID-19 transmission constitute a qualifying reason for requesting an absentee ballot; absentee ballots are also available for registered voters for other qualifying reasons listed on the application. An Absentee Ballot Application may be picked-up at the Village Clerk's Office in Village Hall, requested from the Village Clerk by phone or mail, or most conveniently by downloading one [online](#).

Tuesday, September 08, 2020, is the last day for the Village Clerk to receive an Absentee Ballot Application by mail; however, applications made *in-person* will be accepted until Monday, September 14, 2020. Please note that any absentee ballot already delivered for the March 18 election remains valid and *does not* need to be replaced; such ballots are secure and will be counted.

All Village Election absentee *ballots*, themselves, must be received by the Village Clerk's Office no later than when the polling place closes on election day, whether delivered by mail or in-person.

If you are not a registered voter but want to vote in the Village Election on Tuesday, September 15, 2020, the last day to register with the Westchester County Board of Elections is Friday, September 04.

Mail-in registration forms are available at the Scarsdale Village Clerk's Office, [online](#) from the Westchester County Board of Elections, or in-person at the Westchester County Board of Elections Office, 25 Quarropas Street, White Plains. Please note that although the Voter Registration form indicates that it must be returned to Westchester County at least 25 days prior to the election, at least 10 days ahead of the election is adequate for a Village Election.
