### Sanitation Services Update

Due to the Labor Day holiday being observed on Monday, September 07, all pickups typically occurring on Monday will shift to the Thursday pickup, except for Monday food scrap collection, which will be performed on Tuesday; the balance of the week's [sanitation pickup and recycling schedule](#) remains unchanged.

Apart from the COVID-19 protocols for visitors to the Recycling Center, as described at the end of this press release, the majority of sanitation services have returned to normal scheduling and operation. It should also be noted that special procedures for storm-related debris from Tropical Storm Isaias [concluded on August 25](#), with all normal organic waste rules and procedures now in effect.

Status for each major Sanitation or Recycling service follows:

*Bulk Trash Collection:* Standard curbside schedule, rules and, services; bulk trash is picked-up during one's second weekly collection.

*Comingled and Paper Recycling:* Standard curbside schedule, rules, and services.

*Food Scraps Recycling:* Standard curbside collection and in-person drop-off schedule, rules, and services, except Monday's food scrap route will be completed on *Tuesday* (not Thursday like all other delayed pick-ups). For residents wishing to drop-off food scraps in-person, the [Recycling Center](#) drop-off site is open Monday through Saturday, 8:00 am to 3:00 pm, except the Labor Day holiday.

Please be sure to wear a face covering and practice social distancing. In addition, we have instituted [online ordering](#) (see last tab on second row, "Composting – Sanitation") and contactless pick-up of compostable bags and food scrap bins.

*Furniture Donation Bin:* The Furniture container at the Recycling Center remains closed. As soon as the Village is notified by its recycling vendor that they are resuming their pick-up operation, in-person Furniture Recycling will reopen.

*Mobile Shredder:* This Saturday (09.05.20), from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm, the Westchester County mobile shredder will be located at the Recycling Center. Please review the [County's COVID-19 rules](#) before arriving.

*Take-It-or-Leave-It:* The operation has been suspended due to inability to adequately sanitize donated items in a timely fashion. Notification will be provided when the program resumes.

*Yard Waste:* Standard curbside schedule, rules, and services. Properly tied and bundled branches (less than 5 feet long and 3" in diameter), and paper bags (weighing less than 50 lbs.) containing grass clippings, leaves, and garden materials will be collected separately on the day of the second weekly trash collection.

*COVID-19 Protocols for In-Person Visitors to the Recycling Center:* For the safety of Village staff and residents, a face covering is mandatory when visiting Village facilities, including the [Recycling Center](#). In addition, all visitors requiring entry to the Sanitation office must present a photo ID and submit to a COVID-19 health screening prior to entry.

Please also note that the Village of Scarsdale strives to ensure access to its programs, including Sanitation, in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
