Cooking Oil Recycling Now Available!

The Village of Scarsdale is pleased to announce a new [Cooking Oil Recycling Program](#) as part of our community's ongoing commitment to increase residential recycling and reduce waste, the first such municipal program in Westchester County. The oil we collect through our program will be recycled into [biofuel](#)! The new program is yet another example of the [Conservation Advisory Council](#) working collaboratively with staff to develop and launch beneficial new programs and services.

According to energy.gov, biofuels help reduce our community's carbon footprint, burn cleaner than fossil fuel alternatives, and help enhance reliability of the electric grid by supplementing intermittent forms of renewable energy.

Not only does recycling cooking oil lead result in many important benefits, but it's also super easy!

Scarsdale residents can simply deposit their used cooking oil into the Cooking Oil Recycling Bin at the [Recycling Center](#), 110 Secor Road, during regular operating hours, which are Monday through Saturday, from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM. The bin is located next to the Food Scrap Recycling Drop-off Site. All liquid, vegetable-based cooking oils are accepted; mixing different types of cooking oils is okay.
