### Storm Update: Village Services

The National Weather service continues to forecast between 18" and 24" of snow, starting tonight and continuing into Tuesday morning. As a result, please note that Village Hall and the Recycling Center will be closed On Monday, February 01. However, Village personnel will be working remotely, provided a power outage is not experienced.

Sanitation services will be provided on Monday, to the extent that crews are able to complete their work. Any pick-ups missed on Monday will be picked-up on Thursday. Tuesday's garbage collection is planned to take place as normally scheduled. Public Works, Police, and Fire have activated their storm readiness plans and are geared-up to take on this significant winter storm. The Public Safety Building, 50 Thompkins Road, will be fully staffed, of course. Please stay off our local roads until Public Works crews are able to clear them.

#### Important Safety Information

- Report any downed electric wires to the Scarsdale Police Department at 914.722.1200. Do not approach a downed wire, as electrocution may occur by coming in contact with something else that has been electrified by the downed wire.
- Do not remove caution tape from any location where it has been placed, as the tape is there to protect the public from a known safety hazard, potentially including such dangers as a shock hazard in connection with a live electric wire, an unsafe tree, or other life safety concern.
- By law, drivers must come to a complete stop at any non-functioning traffic signal. However, be aware of drivers that don't.
