Scarsdale Pool Complex Redevelopment Meeting

The community conversation regarding options for the future of the Scarsdale Pool Complex continues with a Public Work Session on Wednesday, September 28, 2022 at 6:00PM in Rutherford Hall and on Zoom.

At this upcoming meeting, the consultants hired by the Village will share a summary of survey results and three preliminary concepts for the Scarsdale Pool Complex in response to robust community input. As a precursor to 2023-2024 budget work, during this next stage of the process, residents' expressed preferences will be matched against projected costs. No decisions have been made about any specific redevelopment plan, and feedback is a welcome and important part of the Board's work in determining next steps.

"We are thrilled that so many Scarsdale residents participated in the pool complex survey this summer," said Mayor Jane Veron. "Thanks to all who submitted their views and our goal on the 28th is to provide concepts that are responsive to what the community has asked for, and to continue to hear their views. As the consultants' condition report makes clear, we must do something if we want to enjoy this community asset for many years to come."

Residents are urged to come to Rutherford Hall on Wednesday, September 28, 2022 to watch the presentation and to share your thoughts.

"This presentation will be followed by meetings with neighborhood associations and community organizations during the fall and winter," said Village Manager Rob Cole. "Residents will have many opportunities in the months to come to consider the future of the Scarsdale Pool Complex."
